

Basic time pattern, with bass drum

Swing the 8th notes.


Start with this ride/hh pattern. Note that each measure of 5/4 breaks down to 2/4 + 3/4:



Add bass drum on 1 (this will be your basic time feel when playing music):




Outline the 2/4 and 3/4 with the BD:




No BD on 1 of second measure:



Move BD on 1 of second measure to end of first measure:



Add double when looping back to the beginning:



Apply the previous sequence to this pattern, with the BD on 1, plus the "skip" notes in the cymbal part:



No BD on 2nd beat 1:



Move BD on second downbeat to the & of 5:



BD double on looping back:



Run that same series with the following patterns:

BD along with the doubles in the ride pattern:



BD along with the hihat:



Basic kicks









Put kicks in other places in the measure on your own.

Snare drum comping

Quarter notes filling out the 2/4 + 3/4:



Quarter notes filling out 3/4+2/4:



SD along with doubles in the cymbal part:



SD plays with the 8th notes in the cymbal part:



Running quarter notes:



Snare drum along with the skip note:



SD fills gaps in the cymbal part:



When playing music, the goal is not to use these complete patterns verbatim; rather, try using the second pattern on p. 1 as your home base, and use pieces of the other ideas you've practiced here as occasional punctuations.
