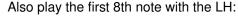
Swing the 8th notes

Fill in &s with left hand on snare drum:



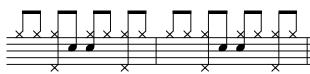




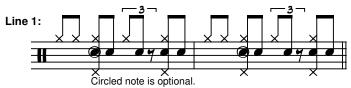








Play quarter note triplets with LH during quarter note part of the measure:





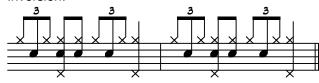




On exercises with three beats of 8th notes, play the quarter note triplets during the 8th notes:
