#### SET<sub>1</sub>

- 1. Play with RH on cym, LH on snare.
- 2. Add 1-2 BD notes per measure, in unison with the RH.
- 3. Add on HH/foot note per measure, on beat 2, or in unison with an L. Or substitute it for an L.













#### SET 2

- 1. Play rhythms on cym with RH.
- 2. Play rhythms with both hands in unison RH on cym, LH on snare.
- 3. Play 1. + 1-2 bass drum notes per measure.
- 4. Play 1. with HH/foot on beat 2.













### SET<sub>3</sub>

- 1. Play high part on cym with RH, low part on HH/foot.
- 2. High part on cym/RH, low part on bass drum.
- 3. High part both hands in unison on cym and snare, low part with hihat.
- 4. High part both hands in unison on cym and snare, low part with bass drum.
- 5. Play high part with RH or both hands, play low part with both feet in unison.

- 1. Listen to Windows from Chick Corea / Now He Sings, Now He Sobs
- 2. Practice exercises
- 3. Improvise.
